



Terms and Conditions – Year 2026

Version 2026

1. Effective Date and Term:

These Terms and Conditions are effective as of January 1st 2026, and shall remain in full force and effect until December 31, 2026, or until superseded by new terms, whichever occurs first. Participation in Charlottesville Tango events during this period constitutes your acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. Notwithstanding the Term, nothing in these provisions shall waive or limit any rights you may have under applicable Virginia law.

2. Code of Conduct:

In addition to these Terms and Conditions, all event participants must abide by the Charlottesville Tango Code of Conduct. The Code of Conduct is incorporated by reference into these Terms and Conditions and sets forth standards for behavior at our events. A copy of the Code of Conduct is available on our social media accounts or can be provided upon request.

3. Right of Admission:

Admission to Charlottesville Tango events is reserved exclusively for our designated participants. We reserve the right to refuse or revoke entry at our sole discretion for reasons including, but not limited to, health, safety, or security concerns, or violations of the Code of Conduct, in accordance with applicable Virginia law.

4. Right to Refuse or Eject:

Charlottesville Tango reserves the right to refuse admission or eject any attendee at its reasonable discretion for, but not limited to, the following:

- Violations of the Code of Conduct.
- Abusive, harassing, or threatening behavior, or conduct that is disruptive or excessively intoxicated.
- Exhibiting symptoms of or having a contagious illness that may endanger others.
- Possession or use of weapons or illegal substances.
- Unauthorized audio, video, or photographic recording.
- Unauthorized instruction or teaching of dance to other participants.
- Any behavior that compromises the safety or enjoyment of other attendees.

All decisions regarding refusal or ejection are final.

5. Ticket Policy:

Tickets and entry passes are non-transferable and non-refundable. Any exceptions must be agreed upon in writing and shall comply with Virginia consumer protection statutes.

6. Cancellation Policy:

In the event of a cancellation, Charlottesville Tango shall not be liable for any costs or expenses incurred by you—including, but not limited to, travel or accommodation expenses—unless required otherwise by applicable Virginia law.

7. Consent to Record:

By purchasing admission, you consent to be filmed, recorded, or photographed. Such images and recordings may be used for promotional or other purposes, whether commercial or non-commercial, unless prohibited by law.

8. Personal Photography:

Personal photographic equipment for non-commercial use is permitted. Please obtain permission before recording video of lessons or performances.

9. Unauthorized Promotion:

Unauthorized promotion, marketing, or selling of products or services at Charlottesville Tango events or in the immediate vicinity is strictly prohibited.

10. Assumption of Risk and Limitation of Liability:

- a. Attendance at Charlottesville Tango events is voluntary and at your own risk.

To the maximum extent permitted by Virginia law, Charlottesville Tango and McGuffey Art Center shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or injury incurred in connection with an event, except for liability arising from gross negligence, willful misconduct, or other liabilities that cannot be waived under Virginia law.
- c. Nothing in these terms limits any rights you may have under applicable law.

11. Health and Fitness:

Participation in our events requires that you are in adequate physical health and fitness. Your decision to participate is voluntary, and you assume all risks related to your physical condition. Charlottesville Tango and McGuffey Art Center are not responsible for any adverse health outcomes resulting from participation.

12. Governing Law, Dispute Resolution, and Severability:

- a. These Terms and Conditions are governed by, and shall be construed in accordance with, the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, without regard to conflicts of law principles.
- b. Any disputes arising in connection with these Terms shall be resolved exclusively in a court of competent jurisdiction in Virginia, except that nothing in these Terms shall exclude liability for gross negligence, willful misconduct, or any other liability that cannot be waived under Virginia law.
- c. If any provision of these Terms is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
